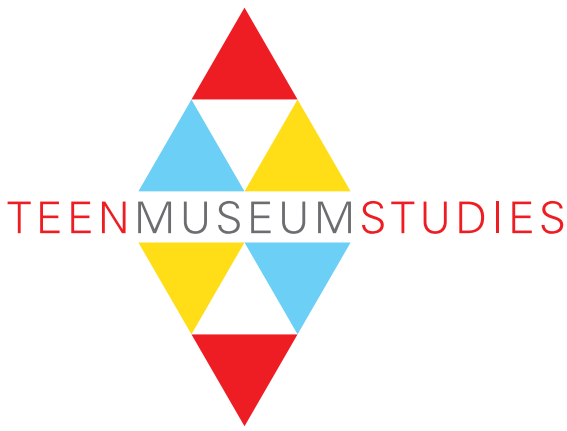
### **APPLICATION DEADLINE: MAY 2, 2011**

*Teen Museum Studies* is designed for high-school students interested in exploring career paths in the museum field. Through workshops, lectures, and staff interviews, students in the program will examine the Contemporary's directorial, curatorial, programming, fund-raising, and marketing efforts. The program provides students with the opportunity to put their new museum-studies knowledge to the test as they organize, curate, and oversee their own temporary exhibition.

*Teen Museum Studies* meets for six Thursday and six Friday sessions in June and July, from 1:00 to 4:00 pm, at the Contemporary Art Museum St. Louis, located at 3750 Washington Boulevard, St. Louis, Missouri, 63108.

Teen Museum Studies has space for 12 dedicated participants. If accepted, students attend free of charge and all supplies will be provided. Accepted students must make a commitment to consistently attend all sessions.

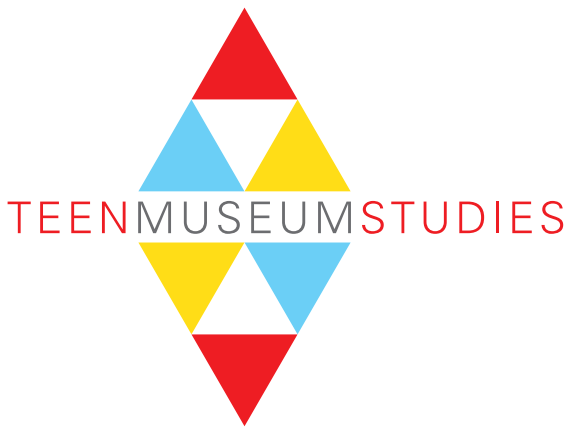
